PROTECTING YOUR HOME

Following are a few security precautions you may consider to minimize the risk this holiday season:

Landscaping: Intruders target homes surrounded by large hedges and shrubs. Trees and shrubbery should be trimmed so doors and windows are visible and unobstructed.

Exterior Lighting: Outside lighting is important near doors and the rear of your home. Motion activated lighting works great.

Interior Lighting: When you leave your

home don't leave a light on. Rather keep a light on a timer, better yet have your TV on a timer.

Locks: All exterior doors should have a deadbolt lock. And remember, don't leave a spare key where it can be seen or expected.

Sliding Glass Doors: To ensure the door can not be lifted off the track from the outside have a pin installed as a precaution.

BACKUP BATTERY...

To ensure protection of your home or business during the loss of power your security system is equipped with a 24-hour rechargeable backup battery. However, these batteries do lose life over time and use. When your battery does reach a low battery status our Central Station will notify you, regardless of the time of day.

For ease and convenience you can change the battery yourself. The battery is located in the control panel, typically located in a closet with a key located on the top of it. Remove the 12volt battery and replace it with a new battery. You can purchase batteries at our office or other stores carrying specialty batteries.

After a power outage, your system may show low battery trouble, allow 24-hours for your battery to fully recharge before considering a replacement.

ADDITIONAL SECURITY TIPS...

- Do not leave ladders or tools outside your home. You just make it that much easier on the burglar.
- Turn down the volume on the answering machine so that burglars can't hear that no one is home.
- Don't hide keys outside your home, they will be found. Instead, install a lockbox, we can help you with that.
- Stow trash away neatly to prevent burglars seeing the packaging of the new electronics you just purchased.
- Make sure to arm your security system!
