HOME BURGLARY STATS & FACTS

- Burglars tend to avoid homes with security systems.
- Most burglaries take place between 10 am—3 pm.
- The majority of break-ins are committed by burglars who live nearby.
- Most criminals can burglarize a home in less than 10 minutes.
- Almost 30% of burglars enter a home through an open door.
- An astonishing 34% of burglars enter through the front door.
- Someone is home during nearly 3 out of every 10 burglaries.
- Burglars usually go to the master bedroom first.

- ✓ Always turn your security system on when you leave the house and at night when you sleep.
- ✓ Make your home look occupied, and make it difficult to break in.
- ✓ Lock all outside doors and windows before you leave the house or go to bed, even if it is for a short time.
- ✓ Leave lights on when you go out. Use automatic timers to turn lights on and off when you are gone overnight.
- ✓ Keep your garage door closed and locked.
- ✓ Don't publicize your absence on social media.
- ✓ Don't leave a spare key outside your home, instead, give it to a neighbor.
- ✓ Install deadbolt locks on all your outside doors.
